

## How to Uninstall plugin

It is necessary sometimes to [update](#) an application control plugin in the Administration console.

You should remove the existing application control plugin before installing a new one.

How to remove an existing application control plugin in the Administration console:

- Click **Start** > type **cmd** in the search line and press **Enter**.
- Use the corresponding command:

- Kaspersky Security for Virtualization 1.1

**msiexec.exe /x {FE88FFF0-6D37-450E-A53B-BF726DD50073} /qb**

- Restart the Administration console after removing a plugin.

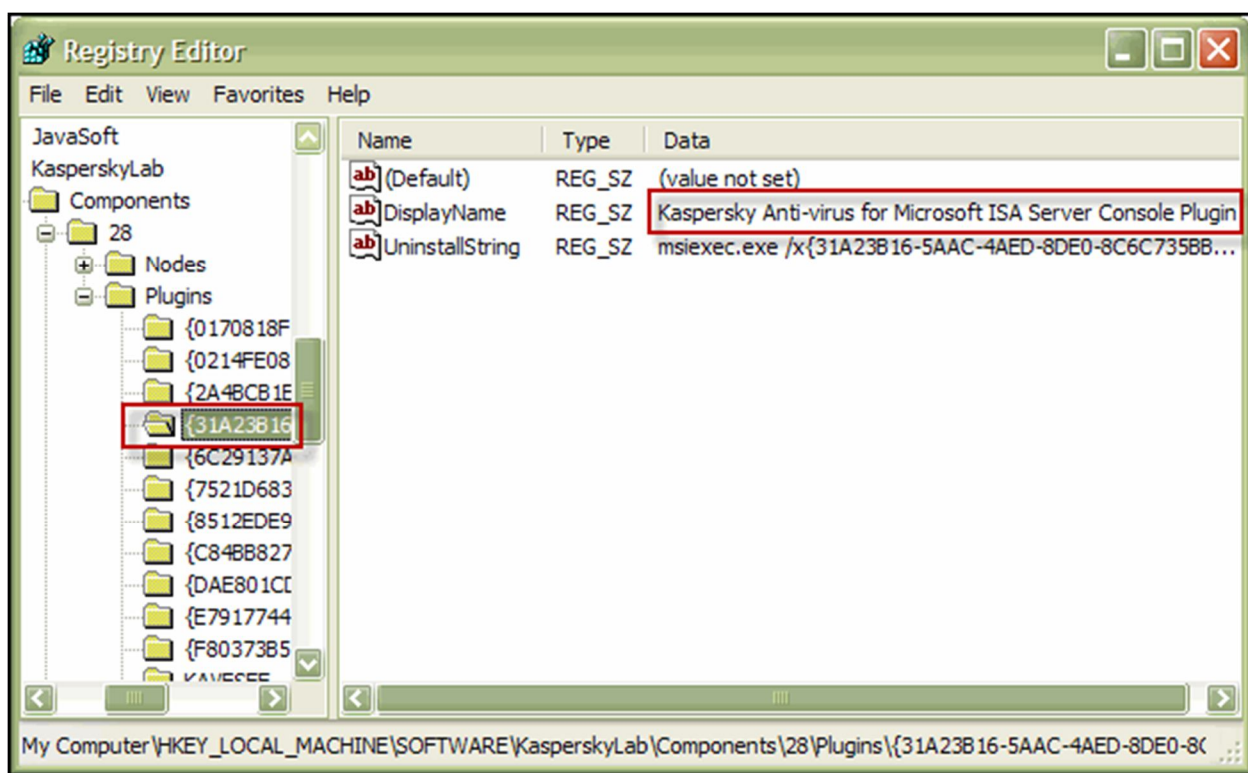

## How to Uninstall plugin

order to remove an application control plugin:

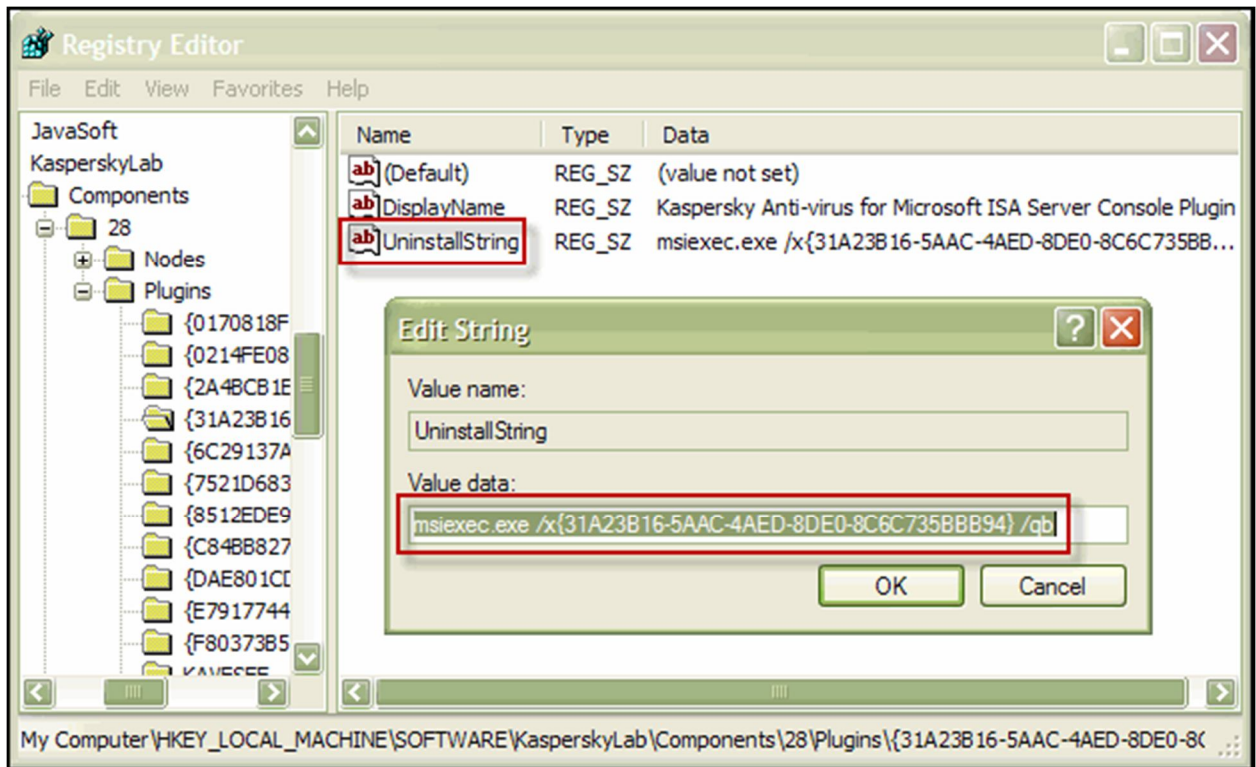
1. Close the Administration console on the PC which has an Administration console and the control plugin you want to remove.
2. Open Windows system registry on that PC (**Start > Run > type regedit > click OK**).
3. Open the registry branch **HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\KasperskyLab\Components\28\Plugins**.

This branch contains a list of all antivirus software control plugins installed in the given Console. The key **DisplayName** contains a name of the corresponding application.



4. Find the branch corresponding to the plugin you are looking for and copy the **UninstallString** key value.

5. Open the command prompt (**Start > Run**), paste the copied value, and run the plugin removal command by clicking **OK** (or press **Enter**).
